Public Hearing – SUPREME OUTDOOR 15252 W. FREEWAY DR. - IUP (PC 18-116)
AUGUST 15th, 2018

The August 15th, 2018 Public Hearing to consider a request for an Interim Use Permit to locate a static billboard sign at 15252 West Freeway Drive, was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Chair Garth Sternberg at the City Hall. Present were Commission members: Pam Wolowski, Jesse Preiner and Jody Krebs; City Administrator Elizabeth Mursko; and Recording Secretary Rochelle Busch.

Also in attendance were City Council members Bill Krebs, and Denny Peterson; Joanne and Robert Stadnik; Dan Eischens; Dan Remes; Joe Bazey; and Ken Levesseur.

Sternberg: Now were going to have a public hearing and discussion for 15252 West Freeway Drive IUP Request pages 1-11 and enclosures. And at this time if the recording secretary could read the notice as published please.

Notice was read at this time by the recording secretary.

Sternberg: Thank you. And at this time if the applicant could please come forward. Hi, welcome.

Wolowski: Have a seat.

Sternberg: And if you could just state your name and address for the record.

Eischens: Dan Eischens, 16634 Festal Avenue, Farmington MN

Sternberg: Thank you. And if you could just give us a little background on what your asking here.

Eischens: What we're doing is were wanting to erect the billboard on this property here. It's kind of one of the last places available here in the city. This is on property that's owned by MIDI properties. They've had it for quite a while. Kind of gone through and done all the measurements, we've done the surveys, I think you guys have all of that information. So, within all the criteria that you've set forth it looks like it fits in. And this is going to be a static sign it's not going to be a digital sign.

Sternberg: Any questions for the applicant?

Krebs: Yes, have you read all the findings of facts and recommendations that were drafted by our City Planner?

Eischens: Yes, we have.

Krebs: Is there anything that you...

Eischens: No, it's pretty standard and were agreeable to everything that's there.

Preiner: Nothing here.

Sternberg: Okay at this time I'd like to open the hearing for the public. Is there anyone from the public that would like to speak? Anyone from the public? Okay, I'm going to close the hearing with the right to reopen.

At this time Chair Sternberg closed the Public Hearing. Hearing closed at 7:03 p.m.
