Public Hearing – 6917 153rd AVE NE VARIANCE REQUEST (PC 18-117)
AUGUST 1ST, 2018

The August 1st, 2018 Public Hearing to consider a request for a variance to permit and construct a mound type septic system of “other construction” (Type III) to replace an existing failing system was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Chair Garth Sternberg at the City Hall. Zastrow: Mary Zastrow, 6917 153rd Ave NE Columbus

Zastrow: So we just need to get a new septic system. We had an engineer come out and do the design for it, and hes the one that said what septic we needed, and I was told I needed a variance, so we put the variance in.

Sternberg: Okay, anything, any questions for the applicant?

Watson: No, Sir.

Sternberg: I have none. So at this point im going to open the hearing for the public. Is there anyone from the public that would like to speak about the variance? Okay, im going to close the hearing with the right to reopen.
