Ordinance Publication Summary**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS CODE  
OF ORDINANCES TO POTABLE WATER REGULATIONS**

The City Council of the City of Columbus adopted Ordinance No. 20-02, an Ordinance Amending Chapter 14 of the City of Columbus Code of Ordinances to Potable Water regulations on April 8, 2020 and approved this summary of the ordinance for publication on May 27, 2020.

The City Council has authority to regulate city municipal code in the City. Following discussion at the City Council, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20-02 to amending Chapter 14 of the Columbus Code of Ordinances to potable water regulations as described in the summary as follows:

**SECTION 14-311. CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS.**

**B. DUAL WATER LINES.** Subject to applicable plumbing and fire code requirements, the City Building Official and the Public Works Superintendent of the City may require installation of dual and separate water lines for fire suppression and potable water to service a commercial or multifamily building. Factors for consideration include actual or anticipated water usage, occupancy, and impacts on the Waterworks system. Dual waterlines must start at the City watermain and have shutoff valves separate from any other water supply to the structure.

This Ordinance was adopted by the Columbus City Council on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of April and shall become effective after its publication. This is only a summary of Ordinance 20-02. In reviewing the 2019 Land Sale (HyVee), and under past practice to pay back the general fund interfund loan for the Quad Land Purchase we have allocated approximately 20% of the proceeds to repay the general fund and allocate the remaining to the Bond Fund. The City Administrator is recommending the following Fund allocation for 12.31.19:

Land Sale Revenue Receipt #20547 \$655,642.57 Fund 480 Land Sales Revenue  
Allocation of Proceeds:

\$525,542.57 Bond Fund 360 (Payment of 2015A Bond Fund)  
\$130,000.00 General Fund 100 Cash to GL & Repayment of Interfund Load to 481 (Allocation in 100 Fund will be determined in the 2021 Budget Discussions)

During the 2018 Budget process, the City Council allocated revenue funds in the total amount of \$13,000 from charitable gambling fund (10% Fund) to the Police Fund 142-4210 (\$7,000) and Fire Fund 142-4220 (\$6,000) the transfer did not take place in December of 2018. The following transfers are reflective the 2018 allocation as we collected the revenue each monthly from Lakes Area Youth and Families, Inc. in 2018 and completed in February of 2019.

**Action:** Transfer Cash of \$7,000 from 230 to Police Fund 142-4210

**Action:** Transfer Cash of \$6,000 from 230 to Fire Fund 142-4220
